Warranty Statement

PWR Steer warrants its Power Steering Products to be free from defects in materials or workmanship when used on privately owned, non-commercial vehicles for as long as such original purchaser owns the vehicle on which the part was originally installed.

The warranty will begin upon the date of first installation on the original vehicle. Subject to the specific limitations as listed in this document, the product, when installed in accordance with PWR Steer installation instructions, will be exchanged if returned to the seller who is authorized to represent this warranty. Proof of purchase may be required. PWR Steer approved instructions are packaged with the PWR Steer product, available through authorized PWR Steer distributors, or may be found at www.pwrsteer.com.

This warranty may exclude failures that are the direct result of, but not limited to:

- Alterations to the OEM suspension and steering system design
- Alterations to wheel and tire size or vehicle height that exceed the OEM vehicle specifications
- Use of non-OE approved fluids
- Internal damage from excessive system debris or extended operation of the vehicle when fluid level is below the OEM minimum capacity specification
- Non-compliance with PWR Steer installation instructions
- Exceeding the OEM specific gross vehicle weight or towing limitations
- Installation on a vehicle that is not specified in the PWR Steer catalog application data
- Fire, flood, explosions, collisions, external damage, physical alterations, disassembly, or missing components
- Use on Commercial Vehicles for more than 18 months from installation.

This warranty is in lieu of all other warranties either expressed or implied, including the implied warranty of merchantability and fitness for purposes which are expressly excluded. PWR Steer shall not be liable for consequential or incidental damages resulting from or caused by the use, operation, failure, or defect of any PWR Steer product.

This warranty grants you specific legal rights, and you may also have other rights which vary from state to state.
